

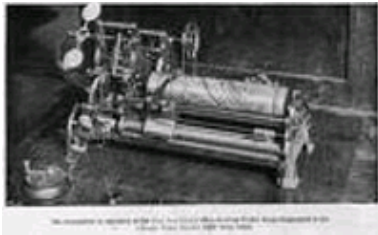

E-Faxing -

When you receive a fax it comes into your inbox as a PDF file that you can save, forward or be careful, print! (Sorry we live in this green world now) Then you

can send your outgoing faxes right through your e-mail as well.

The plans range between \$10 and \$20 a month. It all depends on how many pages you will send and receive. But this will save you money versus the old method of paying the phone company \$40 a month for the phone line. Also what about all the headaches of toner, paper, and did your intended recipient get the fax or not, was the line busy? With fax2mail all those issues go away. Faxing is not dead, but those old fax machines are not exactly getting any younger!

On the Blackberry you can then request/forward the fax pages be printed to that office fax/printer that you are standing in.
