Cell phone, texting legislation news in North Carolina:

Four bills are in committee, including one backed by the AAA and the state insurance commissioner.

Current prohibitions:

1) Drivers under the age of 18 with provisional licenses are prohibited from using cell phones while driving, unless calling parents.

The answer of course is Bluetooth. These laws all allow the use of hands free conversation. Most all phones have



it built in now. If your vehicle has Bluetooth, sync it up with your phone, and you are hands free. If you have a Bluetooth headset, sync it up to your phone and you are hands-free. If you do not have Bluetooth built into your car, checkout a device like the Motorola ROKR T505. It is a

Bluetooth device that you can put on your visor and sync with your Bluetooth phone. You can run all your conversations through the device itself or your stereo speakers. You control the volume of the conversation through the stereo itself. It is much safer than putting that phone to your ear.
